Invitation

The International Conference on Functional Textiles and Clothing (FTC 2027) invites researchers, academicians, designers, industry leaders, and policymakers from across the world to convene at IIT Delhi, New Delhi, for a focused dialogue on the future of textiles and apparel.

Since 2018, FTC has grown into a globally recognized platform at the intersection of textile materials, technology, design, and human-centric innovation, bringing together participants from 400+ institutions across nearly 50 countries. What began as an emerging field has now entered the mainstream, transforming how clothing is designed, produced, and experienced.

Today, functional clothing is at the convergence of advanced materials, sustainability, digitalization, healthcare innovation, climate resilience, and the experience economy. Garments are evolving from passive coverings into active systems - monitoring health, enhancing performance, ensuring safety, and responding intelligently to users and environments. The scope of functional textiles has expanded dramatically. Advances in high-performance & functional fibers, conductive materials, bio-based fibres, nanotechnology, fabric & clothing manufacturing technologies, and responsive surfaces are now being integrated with AI, IoT, digital twins, and extended reality, enabling clothing that is adaptive, predictive, and deeply personalized.

At the same time, the field is witnessing a paradigm shift in garment design and production. Technologies such as 3D body scanning, generative design, mass customization, and digital prototyping are transforming how garments are conceived, tested, and delivered. Functional clothing today must not only perform but also address comfort, inclusivity, cultural context, and user experience, making design as critical as engineering.

FTC 2027 builds on this momentum, offering a platform to showcase cutting-edge research, foster collaborations, and engage with the next wave of innovation in functional textiles and clothing. The conference continues to receive support from key national initiatives such as the National Technical Textiles Mission (Ministry of Textiles, Government of India), reflecting its strategic importance in advancing this sector.

Jointly organised by IIT Delhi and the World University of Design (WUD), the conference brings together the strengths of engineering and design to shape the future of this rapidly evolving field.

Poster Contest

The Poster Contest invites students to present innovative concepts, materials, processes, or products developed by them in the domain of functional textiles and clothing. Submissions may span any of the FTC thematic areas.

Poster entries will be evaluated by jury members considering:

- ◎ Scientific and technical rigour
- ◎ Originality and innovation
- ◎ Clarity of communication and visual presentation

All posters will be displayed during the conference. The first two authors will be provided certificates.

Advanced Materials, Fibres and Surface Engineering -

High-performance fibres, smart materials, nanotechnology, coatings, membranes, and functional finishes.

Culture, Craft, and Policy Futures -

Traditional textiles, craft integration, fashion innovation, policy frameworks, and education ecosystems

3

Digital Transformation and AI in Textiles and Fashion -

Digital fashion, AI-assisted design, AR/VR/XR, 3D/4D simulation, digital twins, virtual prototyping, blockchain, and smart supply chains.

Protective textiles for industrial, military, and emergency use; multi-hazard protection; climate-adaptive clothing; occupational safety and resilience.

Smart and Intelligent Textiles and Clothing -

Wearables, e-textiles, IoT-enabled garments, AI-integrated apparel, responsive systems, soft robotics, and human-garment interaction.

9

Sustainable, Circular and Regenerative Textile Systems -

New and alternate fibres, bio composites, waste valorisation, circular textiles and fashion, recycling, bio-based materials, low-impact processes, lifecycle assessment & design, carbon, water and chemical footprints, regenerative approaches, and sustainable consumption.

10

Technical Textiles -

Fibres and Textile structures for agricultural, automotive, geotextile, industrial and composite applications

11

Textile Characterisation and Quality Management -

Fibre, yarn, fabric and clothing evaluation methods, data driven decision making in textile quality management, AI-ML applications.

12

Textile Chemical Processing -

Innovation in dyeing, printing and finishing; waterless dyeing, applications of plasma, IR, etc.

Value Chain Management -

Operations, finance and supply chain innovations in textile and fashion industry, network design, traceability.

Department of Textile and Fibre Engineering at IIT Delhi is one of the oldest and most prestigious colleges offering Textile Education in India. It has the distinction of being the only Textile Department in the IIT system. It offers one UG program in Textile Technology and three PG programs in Textile Chemical Processing, Textile Engineering and Fiber Science & Technology, besides offering the Doctoral program. Alumni of the department are holding senior positions of responsibility in Indian industry and are employed as teachers and researchers in various organisations round the country.

Teaching and research activities in the department focus on niche and futuristic areas including new manufacturing technologies, Smart textiles, Nanotechnology, Eco friendly processing and Biotextiles. 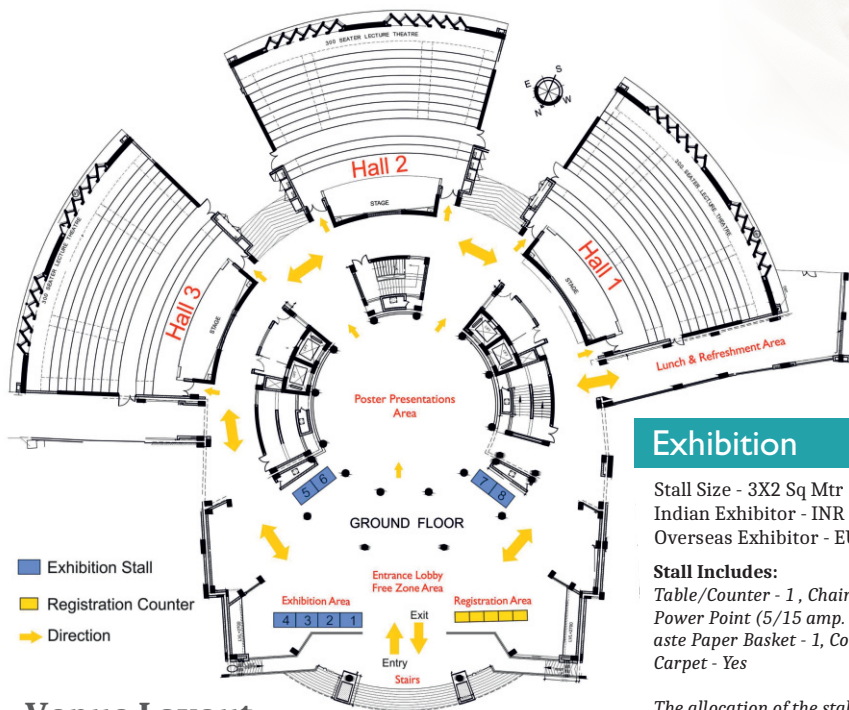

World University of Design (WUD), established in 2018 at Rajiv Gandhi Education City, Sonapat (Delhi NCR), is a university dedicated to education and research in the creative disciplines. Established under the Haryana Private University Act, 2006, WUD is empowered to confer degrees under Sections 2(f) and 22 of the UGC Act. The university offers undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral programs across Architecture, Design, Fashion & Textile, Communication, Visual Arts, Performing Arts, and Business & Management. Within this framework, textiles and fashion form a significant area of academic engagement, with a focus on both design-led and technology-oriented approaches.
